### Children's Illnesses and Accidents

Parents/carers are advised not to bring their child to Playgroup if unwell or infectious. They should advise us if a doctor considers their child infectious and keep them at home until they have recovered.

The nature of the illness is confidential until it is a modifiable disease. If it is necessary to advise other parents of risk this must be done without compromising confidentiality.

If a child becomes ill or sustains injury Playgroup will get in touch with the parent/carer or authorised contact person as soon as possible. The child should be kept calm and comfortable with a member of staff in a quiet area until collected.

Parents/carers sign authorisations for first aid to be administered and/ or an ambulance to be called in case of emergency.
